My Brothers All,

First, I want to thank the Lodge and the brothers for their donations to Project Sunshine. The Electric Cooperatives of Florida are going to bring power to a remote village in Guatemala. As you are aware, I am the team lead for this first ever international project that Florida Cooperatives have undertaken. We will electrify over 30 homes in the village along with a coffee farm that will create jobs and help sustain the community. The coffee farm will be able to process, roast, and package their coffee when the machines are hooked up. The lodge raised over 1,000 dollars to help the children of this village, and if you look at the pictures our brothers will see how poor the community is. While visiting the community for the first time in August to plan the construction that will take place soon I had the opportunity to visit with some families. I asked a young mother what I could bring her back from the U.S. when I returned and she requested a light bulb so her children could do their homeworkThe money the lodge raised has been sent to NRECA International to provide some type of service to the village such as a well, refrigeration, or materials to build a school. Masonic Education: Happy 5785 Brothers! (A.M.)

The year is 5785 Anno Mundi or Year After Creation.

Anno Mundi is used by Scottish Rite organizations to calculate dates. It is based on the Biblical creation of the world from the Hebrew tradition.

There can be some discrepancy in this calculation based on which set of scriptures are used. According to the Greek Septuagin text the world was created in 5500 B.C.E. Even the Tanakh doesn't match perfectly with the Anno Mundi used by Scottish Rite. In the Tanakh it puts it at 3750 B.C.E. The number used by Scottish Rite has it as 3762.



Like many things associated with the Bible and Freemasonry it all comes down to interpretation. The fluctuation in numbers (around 1400 years) is based on how you interpret the Book of Genesis and the age of characters in the Bible starting with Adam and going to Terah the father of Abraham. There is also some discrepancy when it comes to the Biblical flood and the timing of those events.

Regardless, for the Scottish Rite mason the year is calculated by adding 3762 to the current year making it 5785 A.M.

For those looking for some Masonic knowledge, here is a list of the current years and how they associate with Freemasonry:

- It is 6023 Anno Lucis or In the Year of Light. This is the most common of dates for Blue Lodge Freemasonry. It is found simply by adding 4000 to the current year. This represents the Biblical start of the human race.
- It is 905 Anno Ordinis or In the Year of the Order. This is used by the Knights Templar, which is part of the York Rite system in the United States. The date is based on the founding of the Knights Templar or the Poor Fellow Soldiers of Christ. In 1118 the Order was started and the date is found by subtracting 1118 from the current date.
- It is 2553 Anno Inventionis or In the Year of the Discovery. This date is used by Royal Arch Masons and commemorates the building of the Second Temple by Zerubbabel. The date is found by adding 530 to the date. 530 represents 530 B.C.E. the year Zerubbabel built the second temple.
- It is 3023 Anno Depositionis or In the Year of the Deposit. This is used by Royal and Select Masters and Cryptic Masons. It is believed Solomon's Temple was completed in 1000 B.C.E. so the Anno Depositionis can be found by adding 1000 to the current date.

I wish everyone great success in your Masonic and non-Masonic endeavors over the coming year!
