TO ATTRACT GROUP MEETINGS TODAY. THE MASONS, THE WORLD'S OLDEST AND LARGEST FRATERNAL ORGANIZATION, HOLD THEIR NORTH CAROLINA SUMMER ASSEMBLY AT THIS MARKER EACH YEAR, AS THEY HAVE SINCE 1935.

THE MARKER WAS ERECTED IN 1938 IN A COOPERATIVE EFFORT WITH OTHER MASONS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD. ITS 687 STONES WERE SENT FROM THE VARIOUS STATES, 41 NATIONS, AND EVERY CONTINENT, INCLUDING ANTARCTICA. THERE ARE STONES FROM PLYMOUTH ROCK AND FROM THE ROCK OF GIBRALTAR, FROM THE ALAMO AND FROM THE WHITE HOUSE. T. TROY WYCHE, OF THE WAY: ESVILLE LODGE, LED THE EFFORTS TO ERECT THE MONUMENT.

THE SCENIC SETTING OF THIS MARKER, SURROUNDED ON ALL SIDES BY NATIONAL PARK LANDS, WAS CHOSEN TO SIGNIFY THE UNIVERSALITY OF THE MASONS. THEIR IDEALS OF EQUALITY, MORALITY, CHARITY, AND A BROTHERHOOD OF HUMANITY ARE SYMBOLIZED IN THE CEMENT THAT BINDS THESE STONES AND BRICKS.
